THIS IS A LIABILITY WAIVER- PLEASE READ BEFORE SIGNING. THIS FORM MUST BE READ AND SIGNED BEFORE THE PARTICIPANT IS ALLOWED TO TAKE PART IN ANY PAINTBALL RELATED ACTIVITY OR EVEN AND/OR FOR NON-PARTICIPANTS WISHING TO ENTER INTO AREAS DESIGNATED FOR PAINTBALL USE.

IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to participate in any way in the sport and activities of paintball OR to enter into an area designated for paintball use at Canadian Sunday School Mission (CSSM) operating as Ranger Lake Bible Camp (RLBC). I acknowledge, appreciate and agree that:

1. The risk of injury from the activity and equipment involved in paintball is significant, including the potential for permanent disability and death, and while particular protective equipment and personal discipline will minimize this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist;
2. I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE of those persons released from liability below, and assume full responsibility for my participation;
3. I understand that the activities of paintball are physically, emotionally and mentally intense. I understand the rules of play which accompany this document and will comply with all rules and regulations. If I observe any unusual or unnecessary hazard during my participation, I will bring such to the attention of the nearest official as soon as practicable;
4. I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE AND HOLD RLBC and CSSM, the owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the paintball activities, their officers, officials, agents and/or employees ("Release"), WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL INJURY, DISABILITY, DEATH or loss or damage to person or property, WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE, except that which is the result of gross negligence and/or wanton misconduct.
5. I understand and agree that this Release of Liability Agreement covers each and every paintball activity and event in which I participate hereafter.
6. I accept full responsibility for the return or replacement value of the assigned equipment upon termination of the Paintball Camp: Paintball Marker - \$200; HPA tank - \$50; Barrel Sock- \$5; Mask- \$50
- 7. I HAVE READ THIS RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, AND SIGN IT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT INDUCEMENT.**

RULES OF PLAY

1. All players are required to wear masks, ear covering, and clothing covering arms and legs.
2. All protective equipment must be worn at all times and may only be removed in the safe zone or under the express permission of a referee.
3. Barrel socks must be on all paintball markers' barrels at all times and may only be removed with the permission of a referee.
4. ABSOLUTELY NO shooting outside the play area, in the safe zone, or before or after a game.
5. A player is eliminated when a paintball breaks on the player or their equipment. If a paintball hits and does not break, there is no elimination.
6. When tagged out, players must call "HIT", place the barrel sock on the end of paintball marker barrel and walk off the playing field with paintball marker held pointing upwards at shoulder height.
7. When unsure whether a paintball has broken, a player may wipe the spot to check for paint. If still uncertain, a player may call "PAINT CHECK" and a referee will check the area. Play continues unless the referee calls for a halt in play.
8. You may not shoot at a player who has called "HIT".
9. No player shall shoot a burst of more than 3 paintballs at any one player at one time. If more than 3 paintballs in a single burst break on another player, both the player who is hit and the shooting player are eliminated.
10. Never shoot at a player's head unless it is the only target available and never shoot at a player's neck.
11. If a player is within 10 feet of another player, either player may ask to surrender to avoid being hit at a close distance. This has the same effect as calling "HIT." The surrendering player must place the barrel sock on the end of paintball marker barrel and walk off the playing field with paintball marker held pointing upwards at shoulder height.
12. No blind firing. Players must be able to see what they are shooting at.
13. Cheaters are not tolerated. Wiping paint, talking to teammates after being eliminated, or any other form of cheating results in the cheater being disqualified from the game and if repeated, banned from all games for the day.
14. No physical contact between players other than a light tag to the back or shoulder to eliminate a player from the game.
15. For safety's sake, all player owned equipment on this field must be approved by a qualified staff member. All paintball markers must be checked by chronograph to ensure they are shooting at less than 290 feet/second. Personal protective gear must meet safety standards.
16. Only new, clean, camp-provided paintballs may be used.
17. The referees always have the final say and must be obeyed immediately.
18. Be a good sport. Participants who disobey these rules or fail to treat others with respect may be ejected for a game, day, or whole week of camp.
