Leaders are expected to aid their campers in all aspects of the camp program, instruct daily activity sessions (also known as skills) and to assist with the program as directed.

- Oversees and mentors assigned Junior Cabin Leader

## PERSONAL REQUIREMENTS

- Must be a mature individual seeking to honour God with their life. This includes an active and developing relationship with God
- Willing to work flexible hours
- Must be in agreement with One Hope Canada's Statement of Affirmation

## **SKILLS**

- Able to communicate effectively with campers, volunteers and staff
- Experienced in <u>camp activities</u> such as canoeing, wall climbing, ball hockey, handcrafts, and able to teach daily classes in at least three of these areas
- Able to anticipate the needs of campers and address those needs appropriately
- Able to lead Bible studies and has a working understanding of basic Christian doctrines and theology
- Paintball experience is preferable for DIRT Tent Leaders

## **DUTIES**

- Ensure the safety of campers through adherence to "In Safe Hands" training
- Participate in all aspects of camp program, including wide games, chapel, activities, etc.
- Organize campers in maintaining cabin cleanliness
- Ensure campers have good hygiene, including regularly changing clothes, showering, eating at meals, and brushing teeth
- Teach daily skill sessions
- Lead cabin discussions twice daily and answering questions about the Bible and God
- Mentor their junior cabin leader by showing them how to lead skills, cabin discussion, and providing positive feedback regularly
- Create skill plans for activity sessions, communicating with the program director for help
