JOB SUMMARY

Wranglers will assist in:

- Maintaining a safe and effective riding program,
- Maintaining a comfortable and attractive barn/stable area, and
- Incorporating biblical principles in the riding program

- Reports to the Riding Director or head Wrangler, as assigned by the Riding Director

PERSONAL SITUATION

- Must be seeking an active and developing relationship with God,
- Willing to work flexible hours

SKILLS

- Able to communicate effectively with campers, volunteers and staff,
- Must be able to:
 - Handle horses,
 - Ride horses,
 - Properly care for horse tack
- Able to anticipate the needs of campers and address those needs appropriately
- Able to follow the direction of the Riding Director or their designate

JOB DUTIES

- Ensure the safety of campers and staff through adherence to RLBC riding policies and herd management procedures,
- Attend evening campfires and chapel programs,
- Assist with maintaining general campsite cleanliness,
- Groom, tack and un-tack horses,
- Other duties will be assigned by the Riding Director and may include, but not be limited to:
 - Maintaining the stables, riding area and fences
 - Maintaining horse tack and equipment
 - Reporting on medical needs, treatment and behaviour of horses
 - Assisting with treating horse wounds
 - Assisting in teaching riding classes
 - Administering riding program evaluations
 - Participating in evening programs
